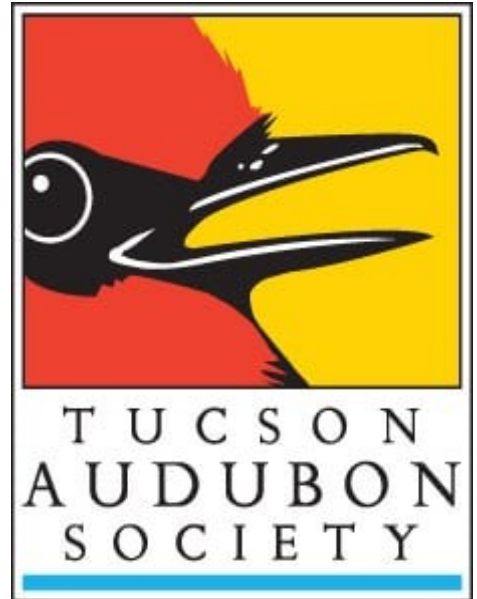

Kids Birding the Parks!

Raffle prizes!



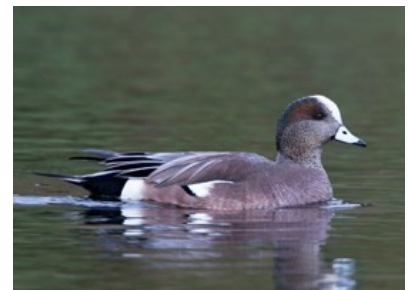
Mallard—Male
