We charge a base fee of \$1900 for the 2-day course or \$2650 for the 3-day course, plus \$105/person which includes the 2-year certification (including CPR/AED and WAT) and Student Manual.

* Client is expected to provide 2–3 patients for the final scenario test; an additional fee will be charged if Tucson Audubon has to provide patients.

** A surplus travel charge will be added for course sites more than an hour from Tucson Audubon offices in Tucson, AZ, or if the instructor needs to stay on site, calculated at \$50/day for each half-hour greater than an hour from Tucson. Example scenario above is for traveling to a site 90 minutes from Tucson

If a second instructor is needed (classes of 12 participants or more), Tucson Audubon will pass this additional cost directly on to the client. This is a cost determined by the certifying agency (Desert Mountain Medicine) and is usually around \$500 plus travel and per diem for that instructor.
